The Law

- Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973
- Titles II & III of the ADA
- Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEA) and the Individualized Education Plan (IEP) see <http://www.fctd.info/factsheet/atiep>
- State laws

Parental Advocacy

- Where do the child's biggest challenges happen?
- What does the child need to do, but is unable to?
 - physical,
 - cognitive,
 - communication,
 - intellectual,
 - social,
 - emotional
- What AT tools are available to help overcome these challenges (think high & low tech options)
- How will you determine if the AT has been successful?

Parental Advocacy

- All are entitled to benefit equally from school activities by way of accessible buildings, auxiliary aids and services
- Deaf/Hard of Hearing/Deaf-Blind students must be given access to all programs and activities offered by a school system.
- Including social and extra-curricular activities.

Parental Advocacy

- Can't charge for accommodations
- Schools need to inform students/parents how to access accommodations via IEP
- Failure to provide access to accommodations is discriminatory
- Post-secondary institutions have obligations under ADA and Section 504, too
