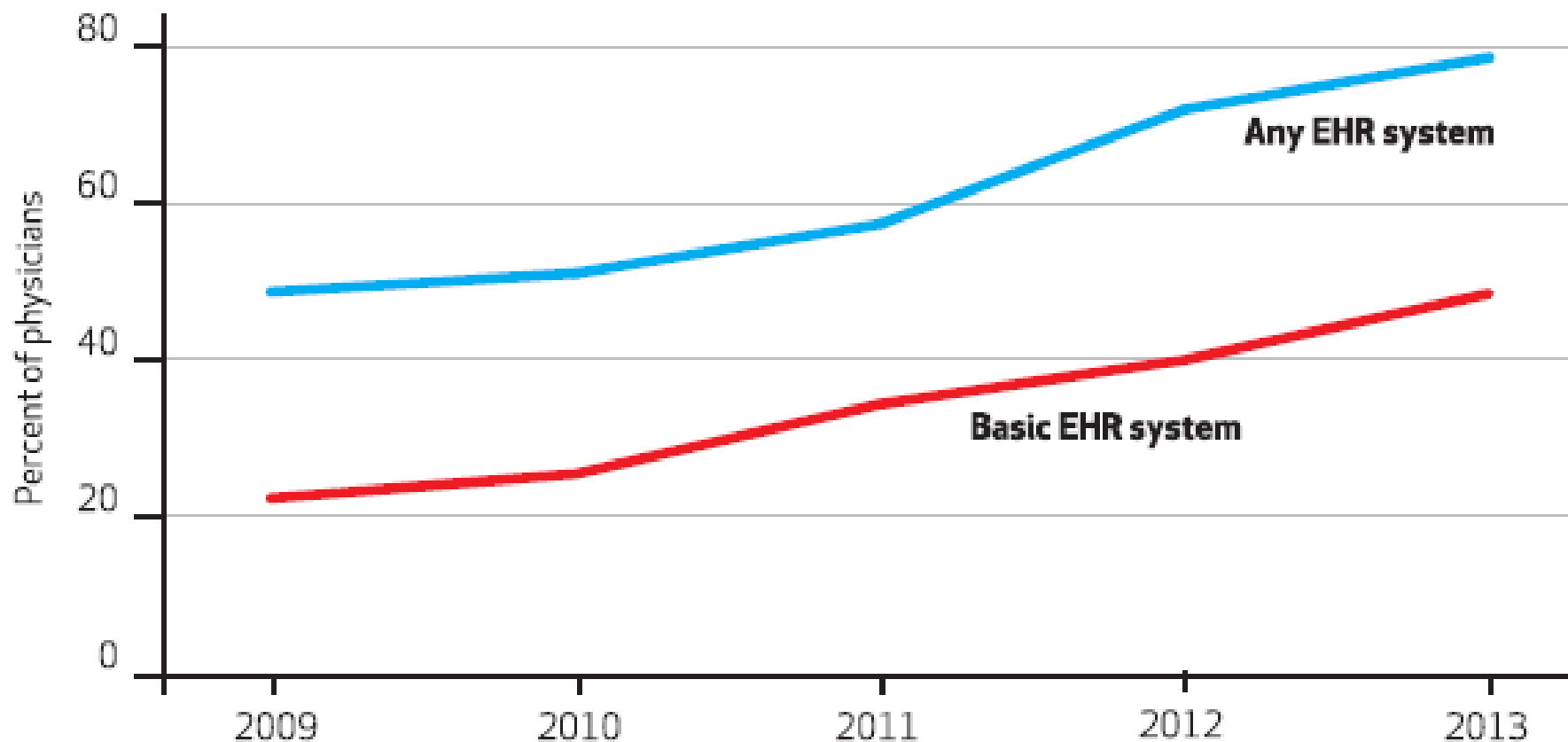

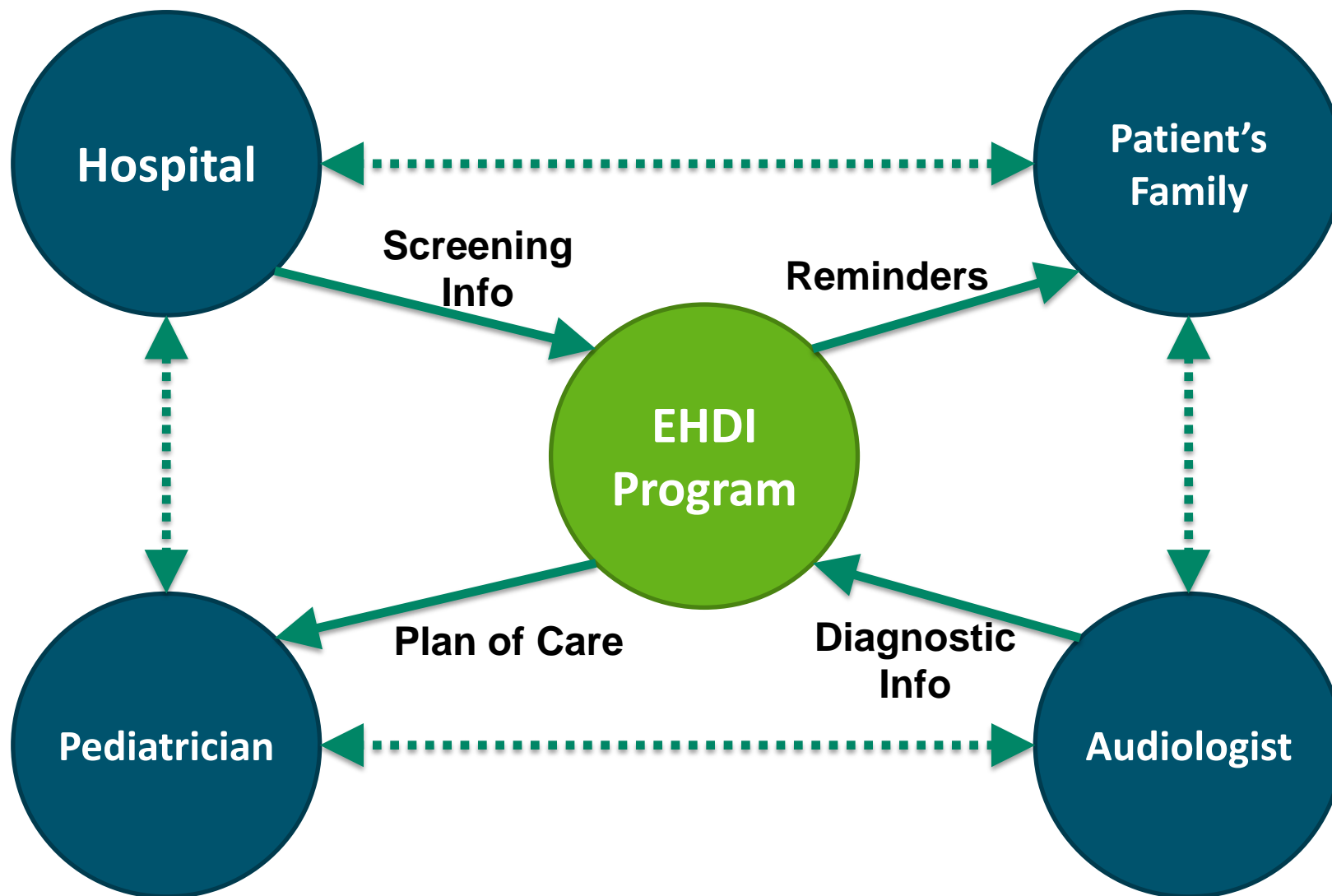

Office-Based Physicians’ Adoption Of Electronic Health Record (EHR) Systems, By Level Of Capability, 2009-13



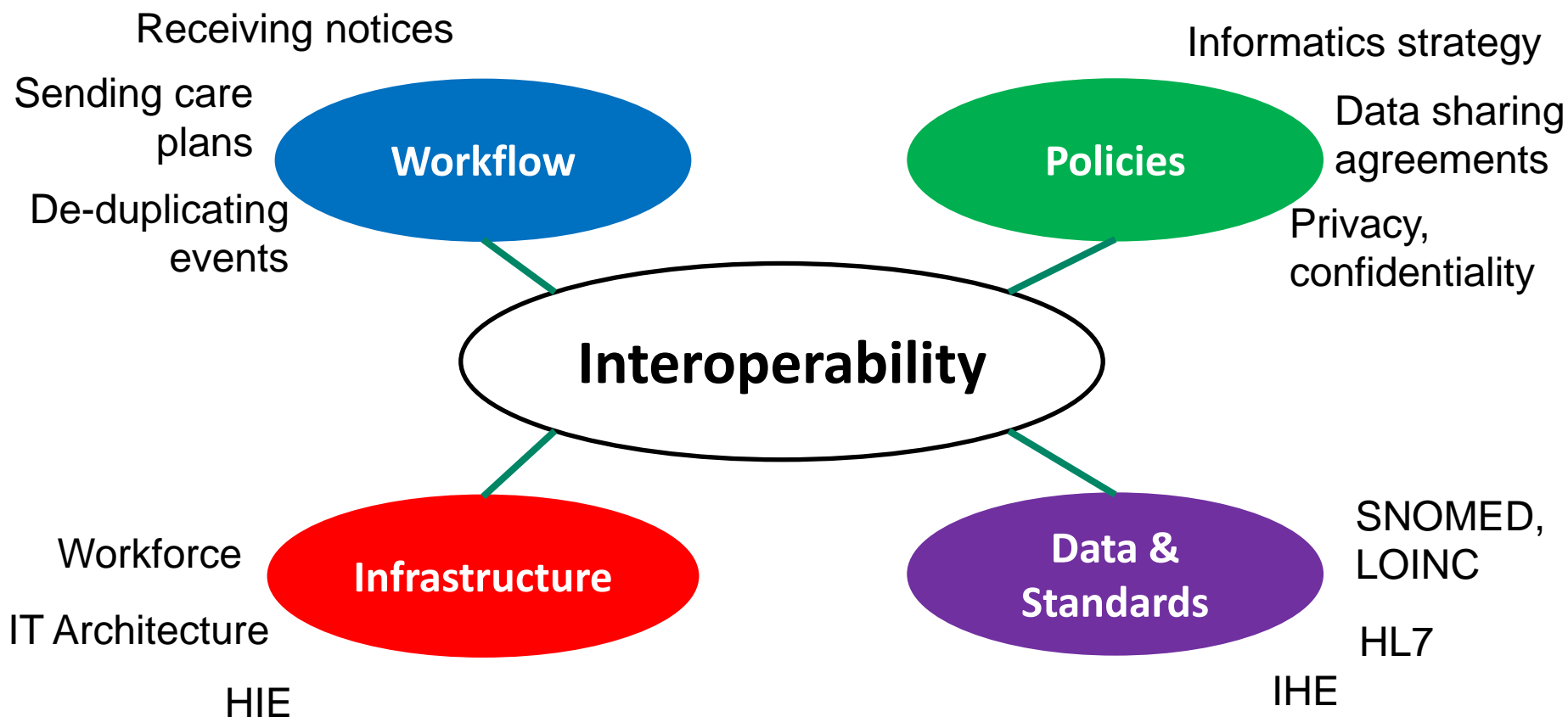

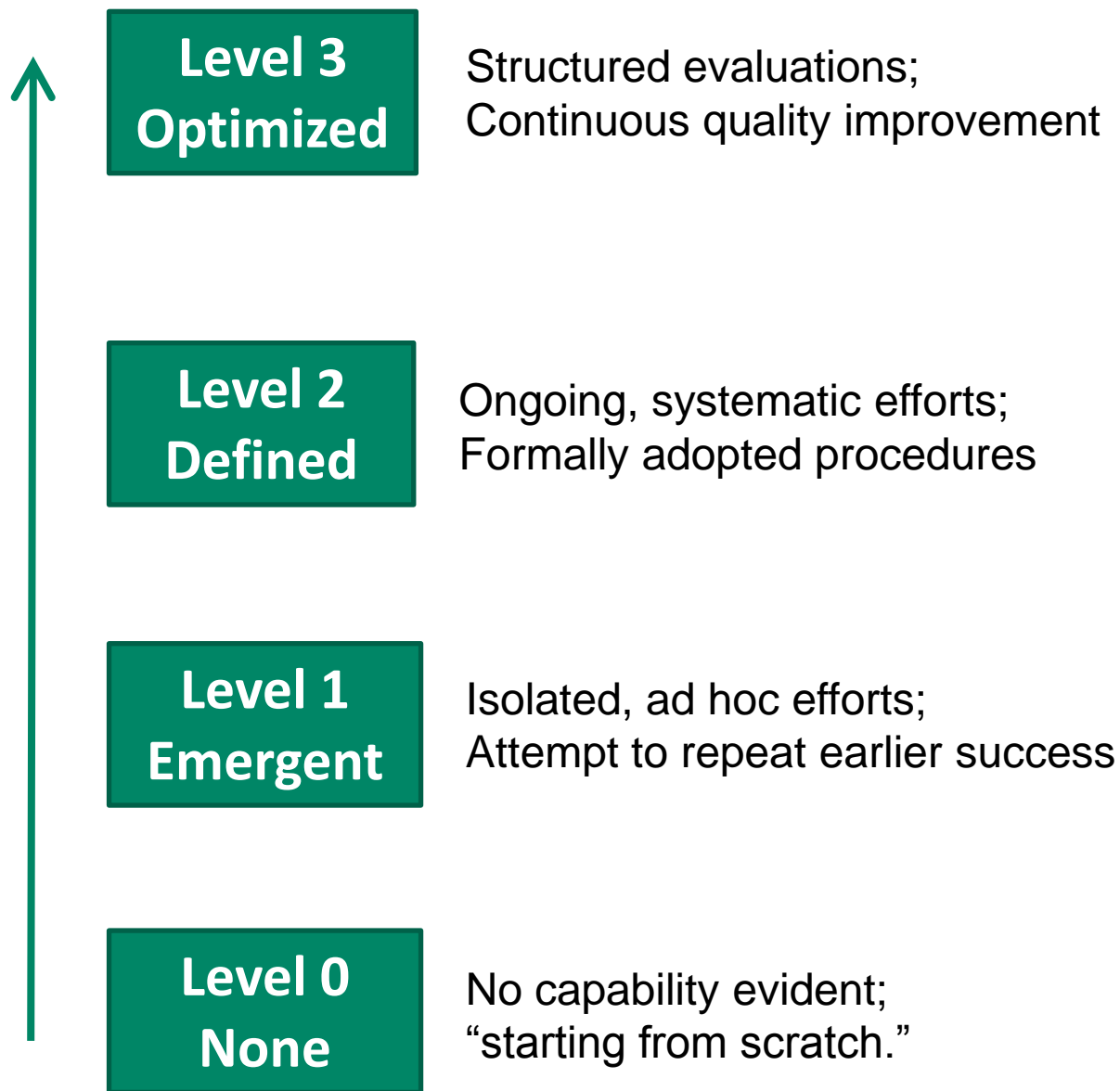
EHDI-EHR Interoperability Self-Assessment Tool



Benefits to EHDI Program

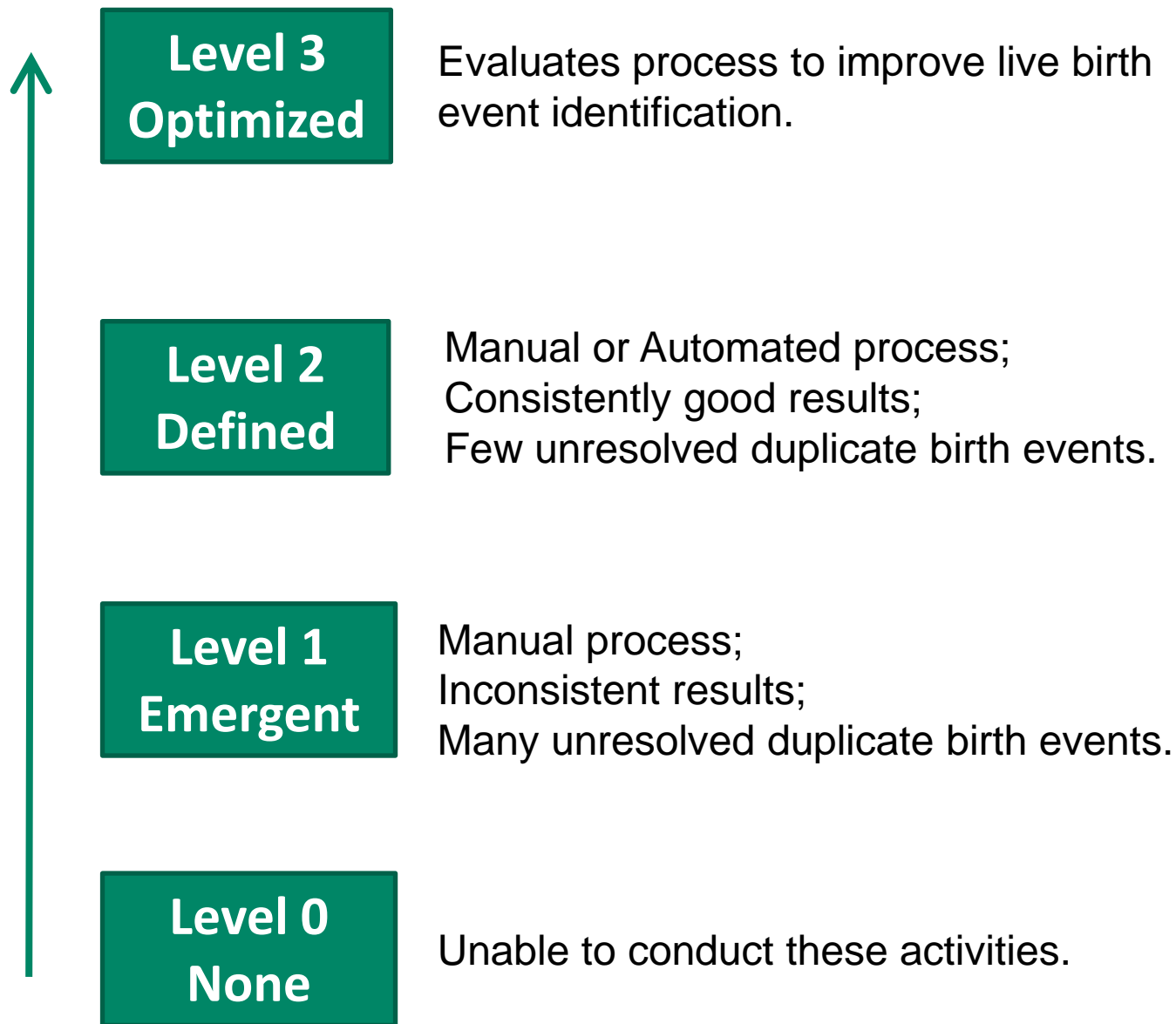
- *Better understanding of current interoperability readiness*
