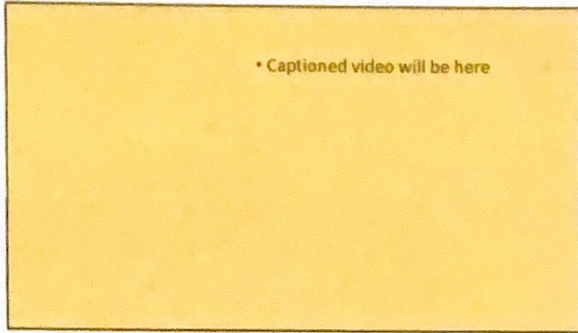

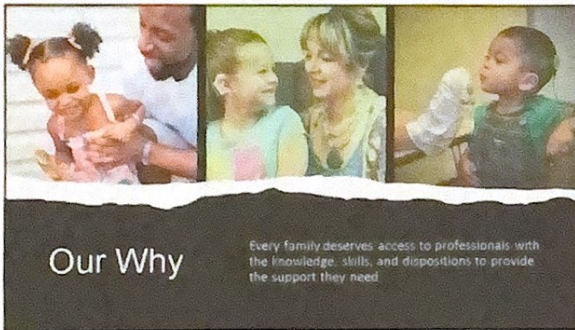

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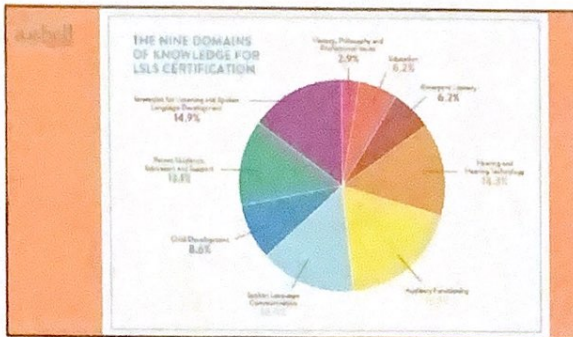

Principles of Listening & Spoken Language Specialists

- Early diagnosis
- Immediate audiologic management and consistent use of hearing technology
- Hearing as the primary sensory modality
- Active, consistent participation in individualized intervention
- Guide and coach caregivers to create environments that support listening
- Integrate listening and spoken language in daily interactions
- Use natural developmental patterns
- Self-monitor spoken language through listening
- Formal and informal diagnostic assessments
- Promote education in regular schools

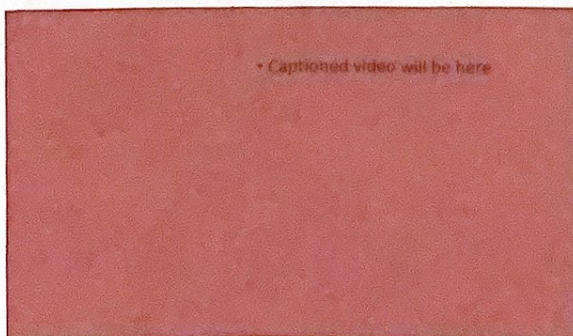
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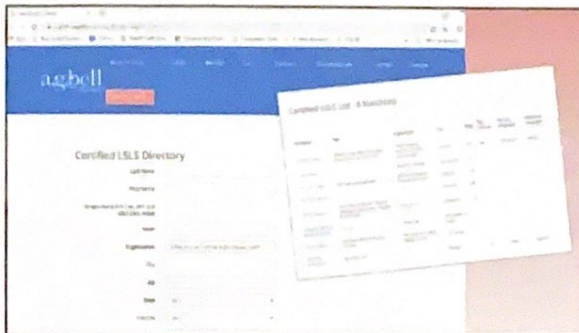
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- ### Academic & Professional Requirements
- Academic: degree in Audiology, Deaf Education, or Speech-Language Pathology.
 - Credentials: license allows a professional to practice in geographic location
 - Mentoring by Certified LSL Specialist for 36-60 month period
 - Professional Experience: 10 hours of observation of LSL Specialist and 900 hours of practice in LSL
 - Letters of Support from 2 parents and 2 professionals
 - Passing score on the LSL Certification Examination (provided in English and Spanish)

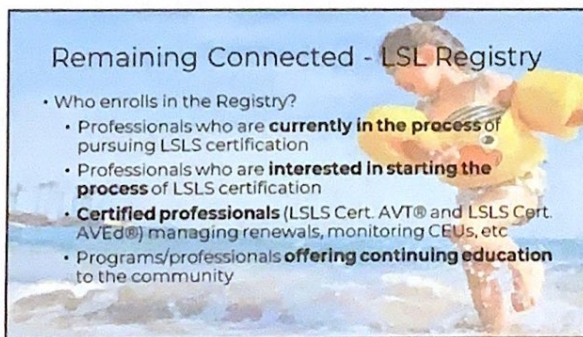
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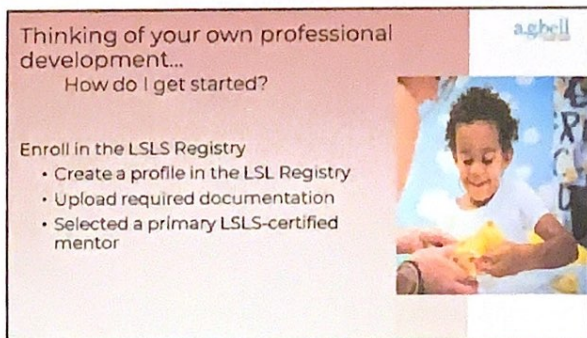
