2007

- 52,670 total births
- 779 were out-of-hospital (1.6%)
- Of those 779/687 (88%) were born with an attending midwife

- 1999 2007 No <u>Direct</u> Midwife support
 - Out of Hospital (OofH) births = 5,523
 - # Screened = 661
 - % screened = 12%






