ASL IS:

- 1.A HIGHLY SOPHISTICATED LANGUAGE.
- 1.A NATURALLY ACQUIRED LANGUAGE.
- 2.THE DOMINANT LANGUAGE OF THE DEAF COMMUNITY IN THE U.S. AND CANADA.
- 2.THE THIRD MOST USED LANGUAGE IN THE U.S.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN ASL AND SIGNED SYSTEMS:

ASL

- IS A NATURAL LANGUAGE
- CONTAINS A LINGUISTIC CODE AS ALL LANGUAGES DO.
- THREE DIMENTIONAL
- GROWS AND CHANGES LIKE ALL LIVING LANGUAGES.
- IS USED BY A COMMUNITY OF PEOPLE.

SIGNED SYSTEMS

- ARE NOT A NATURAL LANGUAGE
- BORROWS ASL SIGNS, INITIALIZES THEM, ADDS NON-ASL ENDINGS TO THEM, AND PUTS THEM IN ENGLISH WORD ORDER
- ARE SYSTEMS BASED ON SPOKEN ENGLISH.
- LINEAR FOR THE MOST PART
- MOSTLY USED IN MAINSTREAM DEAF EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

- 1. HANDSHAPES
- 2. PALM ORIENTATION



- 3. MOVEMENTS OF HANDS, ARMS, AND BODY
- 4. LOCATION TO BODY
- 5. FACIAL EXPRESSION
- 6. WORD ORDER
